

Fresh Till Cowl

When it comes to small projects that are simple, but interesting, our Rebecca wins a blue ribbon. Her inspiration is usually related to some outrageous incident in her childhood. Rebecca's Fresh Till Cowl is reminiscent of these freshly tilled garden rows. The round table knitters have been obsessed with this easy to memorize, perfect for summer project.



Yarn & Needle:

- Cowl pictured is in Madeline Tosh DK, but for a summer, lightweight yarn, we suggest Claudia Handpainted Linen or Kollage Riveting Sport, 1 skein.
- US size 8, 24" circular.

Glossary:

- yo – yarn over
- p2tog – purl 2 together

Cast on **180** stitches. Place marker for beginning of round, and join in the round, being careful not to twist.

Begin Garter Stitch Border:

- Round 1: Knit
- Round 2: Purl

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 once more, there will be 2 garter stitch ridges.

Begin Fresh Till Pattern:

- Rounds 1-5: Knit
- Round 6: Purl
- Round 7: *yo, p2tog* - repeat between * until end of round
- Round 8: Purl

Repeat rounds 1-8 until you have three tilled rows. Knit 5 rounds.

Begin Garter Stitch Bottom Border:

- Round 1: Purl
- Round 2: Knit

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 once more, there will be 2 garter stitch ridges.
Bind off.
